We are extremely delighted to report that this year marks the 20th year since the school opened its doors to the public at large. This school was opened on 26th Feb 2004.

For the last 20years, the school has positively changed the lives of many students.

More than 2800 students have received secondary school education and are helping their parents and contributing positively to the economic needs of our Country.

The poor and the destitute were also absorbed by the school. In 2018, the school offered scholarship for bright and needy students. Every year from 2018, the school sponsored more than 10 students from communities in Mambtui, Tana River, Mombasa, Kakamega etc. These needy bright students were drawn from both Muslim and Christian communities



Today, the school has managed to offer scholarships to more than 100 students both in secondary school, Diploma Colleges and University levels.

Majority of students have gone through universities and mid level colleges. Many are now degree and diploma holders in the following fields;

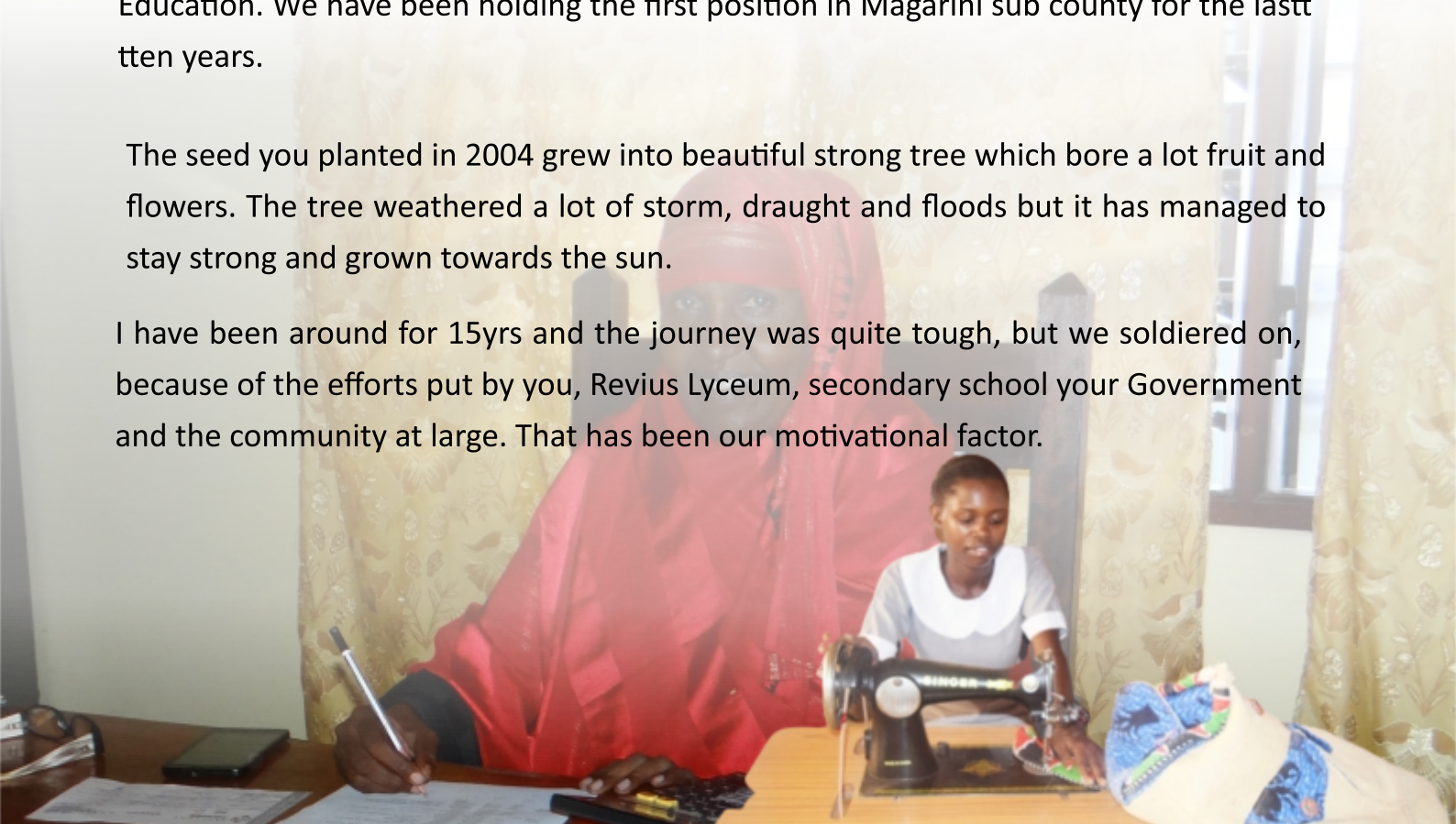

Members of the Trust and Board of Management have cushioned the school from all the storm. They have been hands on in helping the school run smoothly. The good work you started brought in many donors who put up buildings and water wells for the students.

Over the years, the school has also managed to acquire two vehicles through our fee collections.

We are indeed very happy and grateful; however, we are facing a few challenges which have been brought about by the shift in our school curriculum by the government over the educational system which has been overhauled and has affected all the secondary schools in the country.

Secondary schools will now offer a 3 year course instead of four. (Instead of forms 1,2,3 and 4, we shall have grade 10,11,12).



This automatically translates into loss of revenue and reduction in manpower. Majority of the secondary schools in Kenya will experience loss of revenue in the year 2025.

The School Trustees and Board members have decided to survey the possibilities of starting an income generating activity to offset the financial needs in future.
